

Memorial Garden Plaques

The Memorial wall in the St James churchyard, High Wych is a place where loved ones whose ashes are interred in the garden of remembrance can be commemorated on a plaque.

If you are considering remembering your loved ones in this way, please read the following before completing the order form (below)

- Commemorative plaques are a uniform size and shape (12.5.x7.5cm) and permanently fixed to the Memorial wall.
- Orders can be place by completing the application form and inscription form (below). You will be asked to approve a design before it is manufactured and be informed once the plaque has been installed,
- Plaques will be installed and positioned in the order that they are supplied.
- Where two people share a plot (eg. husband and wife), they can be commemorated on one plaque, but this will affect the size of the lettering.
- Consideration can be given to including plaques in memory of loved ones buried elsewhere. *Please make contact before submitting an application.* In these cases, the plaque should carry the words 'buried elsewhere' or give the location of the burial.
- Once an order is placed it can take 3 months before installation is complete.
- All unauthorised markers on the ground will be removed so that the Garden of Remembrance can be maintained.
- All inscriptions are subject to approval by the priest in charge,
- **The cost for 2023 is £408.00. (£324.00 for manufacturer and £84.00 statutory fees)** This is inclusive of providing and fixing the plaque, church fees and VAT.
